Here are a few ideas you can do now as a family to enrich your child's journey of faith.

- If you have not done so already, purchase a family Bible and keep it in an easily accessible and visible place in your home. If it includes a Family Record section, complete it together. If not, have each family member sign his or her name with full birth date on an inside cover page.
- Take time to read together the Gospel stories your child will read in class. Discuss what Scripture teaches us about Jesus and his love for us.
- After each lesson in The Life of Jesus section, work with your child to complete
  the related activities. Read each Family Page and implement the ideas to help
  your child better understand the Gospel story. Finally, pray together the prayer
  on the Family Page.
