

Miracle Stories

1. Distribute Bibles to the children. Tell them to choose one of the stories to look up and read. Point out that if a story appears in several different Gospels, then they will see more than one reference. The different versions will give them more details.
2. As they are reading their stories, distribute art paper, crayons, or markers for the children to make storyboards of the miracle story they have read.
3. Invite them to draw a long rectangle with three sections. In each frame, they are to illustrate one part of the story they read. Display their completed work for all to see.
