- Hands Up; Hands Down

  1. Tell the children that you are going to read several statements. Invite them to raise their hands if the statement is an example of loving and serving God, as Jesus asks us to do. Tell them to keep their hands on their desks if the statement is not an example of loving and serving God and others.

  —Joey does not pick up his toys.
  —Ella lets Jake ride her scooter.
  —Dakota helps his mom pack a food box for the poor.
  —Julie will not share her seat on the bus with the new girl.
  —Tim's family picks up trash in the park.
  —Claire pushes Matt out of line.

  2. Praise the children for their responses. Remind them that when they live as Jesus taught, they are serving God and others.
