

Making a Healing Prayer Chain

1. Before class, cut 1" X 6" strips of construction paper, at least one for each student.
2. As you discuss the children's faith choices on page 132, help them to understand that one of the ways they can reach out to the sick and suffering is through prayer.
3. Ask each of the children to think of a person (a neighbor, a grandparent) or group (people with cancer, children in the hospital) in need of healing.
4. Ask them to choose one of the people they thought of and write the name on the paper strip.
5. Show the children how to make a prayer chain by using a glue stick to loop the strips and link them together.
6. Place the prayer chain on the prayer table in your classroom. Have the children add to it whenever they learn of someone in need of the Lord's healing.
