

Creating a Word Web

1. Distribute unlined paper to the students.
2. Have them write the word “Marriage” in the center of the page and circle it. Do the same on the board as an example for the students.
3. Ask a volunteer to name one quality that is essential for a couple to develop if they are to have a happy and holy marriage.
4. Draw a line from the center circle and write the quality that is named (friendship, patience, honesty, faithfulness, and so forth) at the end of the line.
5. Have the students work independently to create individual word webs.
6. Afterward, invite volunteers to share with the class one quality they included on their word web.
7. Discuss with the class why it is important to begin now to develop the qualities they named. Point out that the living according to Jesus’ teachings helps to prepare us for a loving marriage.
