

## Debating the Importance of the Liturgical Seasons

1. Divide the children into six groups.
2. Assign each group a liturgical season.
3. Explain that each group will tell the rest of the class about their season.
4. Encourage the children to present their season in a way that will persuade the rest of the class to think that their season is the most important in praising, thanking, and honoring God. For example, the children who tell about Lent want the other members of the class to think that Lent is the most important season for Catholics to worship God.
5. After each group has presented their season, have the whole group vote for the small group that was most persuasive.
6. After praising the children for their presentations, summarize by emphasizing that each season of the Church Year is important in helping us to celebrate our life in Christ.
