

Family Time 5: Healing Miracles

In this session, your child learned that Jesus worked miracles to invite people to have faith in God. The young people read about two miracles: Jesus' healing of Jairus' daughter and the healing of a woman with a hemorrhage. Re-read these miracles stories as a family from your family Bible (Matthew 9:18-26, Mark 5:21-43, or Luke 8:40-56).

These stories help us to understand that we can reach out to Jesus when we are afraid, suffering, or in need. They also remind us of the importance of praying for those who are in need of physical or spiritual healing.

Help your young person understand that God hears and responds to our prayers, although we may not always receive the result we think we need.

Pray the prayer below together as a family. Remind everyone that in response to our prayers, Jesus can and does continue to work miracles in the world.

A Litany of Faith and Trust
